- △ Beaux are mentored by positive adult male role models during program workshops.
- △ Beaux meet and form lifelong bonds with students from other schools and backgrounds.
- △ Beaux raise funds for scholarships by soliciting donations/sponsorships and selling advertisements in a souvenir journal.

- △ Male high school juniors or seniors from public or private schools in the Greater Tampa Bay area
- △ Possess high moral character and a willingness to obey the program rules and regulations established by the Sorority
